

RULES AND CONDITIONS

- No horse or pony to compete more than once in any one class. No horse or pony under 4 years of age is eligible. Stallions by prior agreement only
- There will be a timed section for all classes—Optimum time, will only be taken if all else is equal.
- Riders must report to the collecting ring 10 minutes before competing and have their tack checked.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry, cancel a class, withhold a prize or disqualify a competitor for any reason they deem necessary.
- Competitors failing to obey the instructions given by the Fence Judges, Stewards, Judges or other officials will be disqualified.
- Hard hats to the correct British standard must be worn, properly adjusted and fastened, at all times when mounted. Body protectors and Medical Armbands are compulsory. Hunting Jackets or cross country colours must be worn. (long sleeves are compulsory)
- Hats must be checked with the secretary before being mounted.
- The Judge's decision is final. Any objections or protests must be handed to the Secretary, in writing, with a deposit of £10 within 10 minutes of the results being published. The deposit will be retained if the objection not upheld.
- Part entry fee refunded only on production of a vet's/doctor's certificate.
- If competition cancelled, an admin fee will be retained before refund of entry fee.
- No Farrier on call – Please ensure your Horse / Pony is well shod.
- Dogs must be kept on a short lead and under control at all times. Young children must be supervised at all times.
- Horses and ponies must not be left unattended in the lorry park unless secured correctly inside a trailer/horse box.
- Age as at 1st January 2010
- After 3 refusals at one fence a rider may continue at the discretion of the fence judge, but must not in any way impede other competitors.
- Competitors who receive first aid treatment may only continue if the Paramedic considers they are fit to do so.
- Any horse/pony jumping Hors Concour must remain so for the rest of the event.
- Riders should have their own insurance

Legal Liability: No responsibility can be taken for the theft, loss, damage, accident or illness caused to persons/animals/property or vehicles attending this event.

Health, Safety & Welfare: The organisers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all Officials and Stewards.
